

#### **CSDS Thesis Excellence Award**

The Centre for Sustainable Development Studies (<u>CSDS</u>, University of Amsterdam) is proud to present the CSDS Thesis Excellence Award, recognizing one outstanding master's thesis and one outstanding research master's thesis on sustainability. The award includes a prize for the best thesis in each category (masters and research masters), and up to two runners-up will be honored with certificates of excellence. The winners will also showcase their thesis to a diverse audience of scholars and industry professionals during a CSDS Symposium or Lecture Series.

## **Eligibility**

- The thesis was written in an UvA FMG department and received a grade of at least 8 0
- The thesis should relate to CSDS's research focus, and thus address environmental sustainability, climate change, SDGs, environmental justice and transitions, ecofriendly behavior, or related topics.
- The thesis was written and graded in the 2023-2024 academic year. Please submit the original thesis, not any later documents such as preprints or journal publications.

#### Selection criteria

- Relevance to CSDS research areas
- Theory development or advancement
- Rigorous methods
- Ethical practices according to discipline norms
- Potential for societal impact
- Writing quality

Students may nominate themselves. Supervisors or other parties are also welcome to nominate eligible students.

Please submit all documents in PDF to <a href="info-csds@uva.nl">info-csds@uva.nl</a>: the original thesis, a copy of the final grade form, and a short statement of max. 150 words in which you explain the strengths of your thesis to the interdisciplinary committee. Please also provide the following details: the name and email address of the author, and the name, and email address of the thesis supervisor(s).

# **Conditions for Participation**

- The submitted thesis must be the original thesis, not any later documents such as preprints or journal publications.
- The thesis is available unconditionally and in full for members of the jury and co-readers. The thesis will be made public: there are no restrictions for interested parties who wish to peruse the thesis unless copyright, privacy or confidentiality exceptions apply. In such a situation, these restrictions must be submitted as a reasoned argument to the jury, who will then make a decision regarding the exception. In case of potential publication plans, students are advised to consult with their thesis supervisor(s).
- Relations by blood or affinity of jury members and CSDS board members are excluded from participation in the CSDS Excellence Thesis Award.

## Special provisions applicable to the winners

- The winner grants CSDS permission to publish and reproduce their rewarded thesis, which may include publishing their thesis on the CSDS website.
- The winner is willing to present their rewarded thesis in at least one form (i.e., blog, video, podcast etc.) for publication on the CSDS website.

#### Jury

- The jury reserves the right not to award the CSDS thesis award in the event of an insufficient number of entries and/or an unsatisfactory quality of the submissions.
- Jury members will refrain from evaluating theses authored by candidates whom they have supervised.
- The jury's decision is final and not subject to debate.
